Shift Mathematics Lab. to one of the Science Lab.

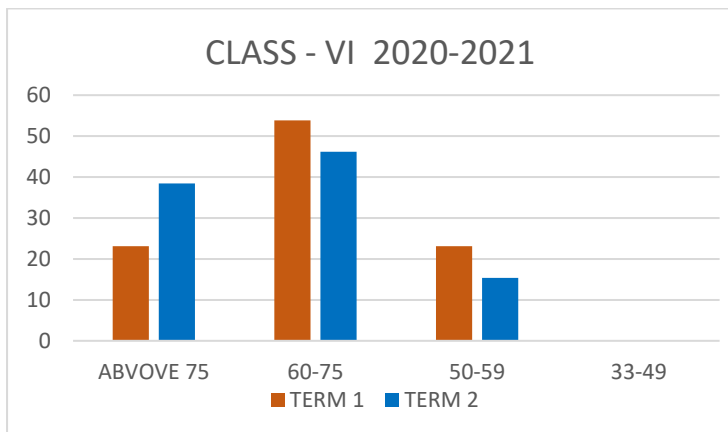
Fixture of separate cabinets for Counselling

Setup of Language Lab by Academic year 2022-2023

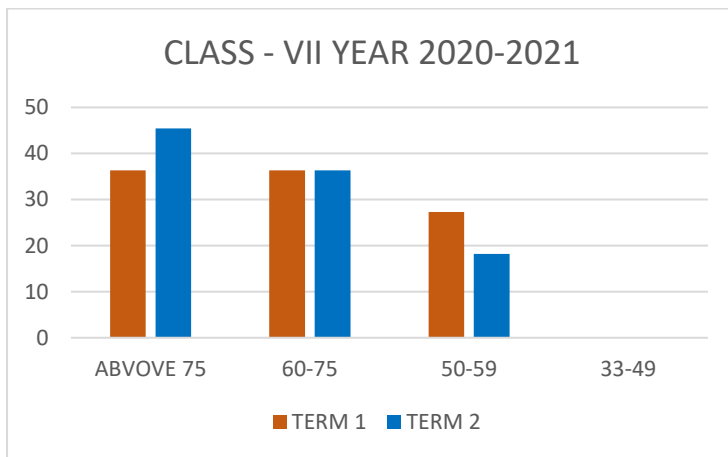
Expenditure Budget was finalised and accepted by SMC.

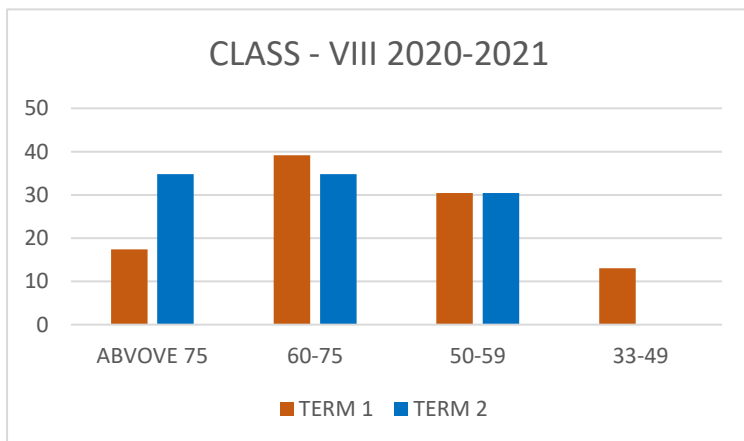

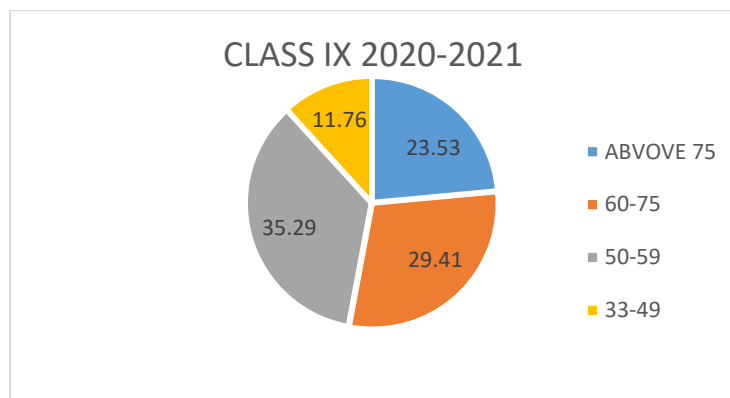

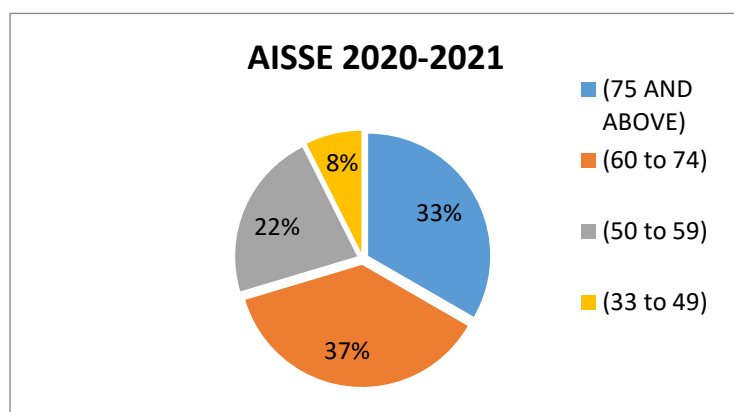
